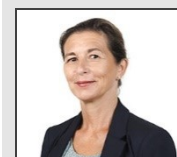

Format

Each team must prepare a written report in advance of the training, which will be defended at the semi-final.

The semi-final will be organised as follows:

- Oral defence of the written report in plenary
- Each team has 5 minutes to introduce itself
- Each team is given 20 minutes to present its written report
- The jury will ask questions of each team
- The teams have 15 minutes to prepare their answers
- Each team is given 10 minutes to answer the questions
- The jury comments on each team presentation
- The jury announces the two winning teams invited to take part in final
- The best two teams from each semi-final will take part in a three-day final held at ERA's premises in Trier and at the General Court of the European Union in Luxembourg on 6-8 October 2025
- Teams not participating in the final will be offered the opportunity to participate online in the training on "How to Litigate Before the Court of Justice" on 6 October 2025

Participation costs

1. Young lawyers nominated by Bars financing the project participate free of charge or will be reimbursed by their bars. For participants applying independently or through other Bars, a fee of **200 Euro** will be charged, including costs for documentation, lunch(es), coffee break(s) and dinner(s). No discounts are given.

Travel, Accommodation and Catering

2. Applicants will be subject to a selection procedure. ERA will send confirmation of selection to each participant individually. Confirmed participants are eligible to receive a fixed contribution towards their travel expenses following the event.
3. The precondition for payment of the travel cost contribution is confirmed attendance at all events (webinar, dinner, contest). Travel cost contributions are based on the distance between the place of work and the event venue (distance only one way – reimbursement amount is for the total travel cost) location and will not take account of the participant's actual travel and accommodation costs. Please note that no contribution can be paid for travel under 50km. The reimbursement will be calculated as follows:

51-199 km	€ 100
200-399 km	€ 200
400-600 km	€ 245
601-800 km	€ 261
801-1200 km	€ 276
1201-1600 km	€ 288
Over 1601	€ 369

4. For the semi-finals, participants shall book their own accommodation. The condition for payment of this contribution is to participate and sign all attendance sheets at the event. No supporting documents (i.e., invoice, ticket or boarding pass) are needed. Accommodation cost contribution (1 night) for the YELC semi-finals:
Semi-final in Barcelona: € 160
5. Successful applicants will be sent the relevant claim form and information on how to obtain payment of the contribution to their expenses. Please note that no payment is possible if the registered participant cancels their participation for any reason.
6. Catering: ERA provides dinner the evening before, lunch and coffee break during the semi-finals.
7. No per diem or daily allowance is available.

Participation

8. Selected participants will be asked to book their travel as soon as possible and confirm their itinerary to ERA.
9. Participation at the whole contest is required and participants' presence will be logged. A list of participants including each participant's working address will be made available to all participants unless ERA receives written objection from the participant no later than one week prior to the beginning of the event.
10. Participants are asked to give permission for their address and other relevant information to be stored in ERA's database in order to provide information about future ERA events, publications and/or other developments in the participant's area of interest.
11. A certificate of attendance will be distributed after the end of the conference.
